e – Present two reasons someone would answer **YES** to the question you chose.

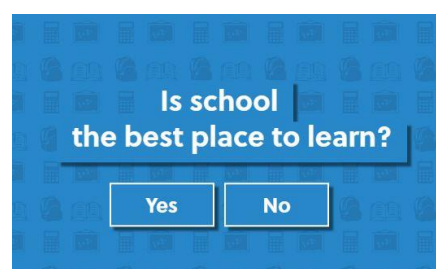

Did the information that you read here influence your opinion on the matter?



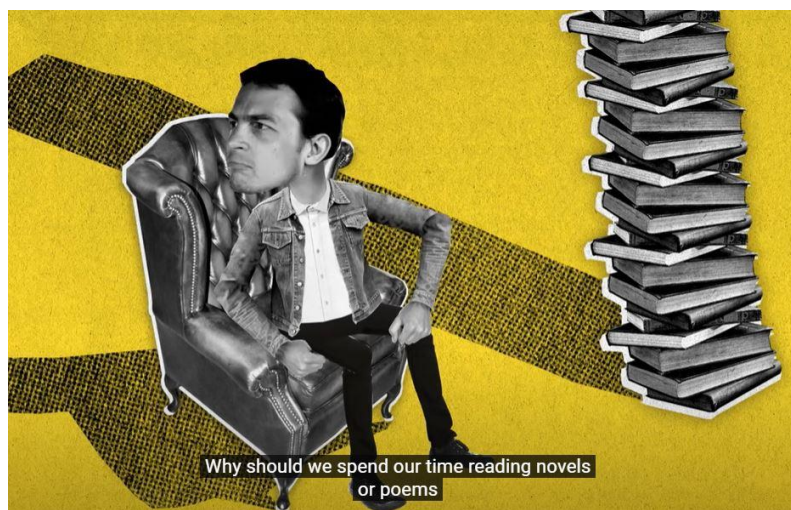
